



PLEASE NOTE THE INFORMATION REGARDING MOST FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Sentia The Global School was established during the year 2008-2009 by Vidya Kshetra Educational Society. Mr. A. Deepak is the Founder and Chairman of the school. Mrs. A.Sunita is the Academic Head of the school. The school is affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi, vide affiliation No. 3630065. At present the school has about 2300 students. It is a coeducational school and the school does not have boarding facility. We have no branches elsewhere.

2. At Sentia The Global School, we believe that every student can achieve excellence in a conducive atmosphere that is encouraging and challenging. The school offers students the best resources and facilities. By instilling high values, we create opportunities for students to develop their full all round potential. Our high standards and academic excellence groom students to be responsible world citizens.

3. The class students ratio is 1:30 in classes PP I to XII and the school timing is from 8.10 am to 3.15 pm. The class rooms are not airconditioned, however the school building is constructed in an environmentally sound and well ventilated manner to create comfortable and good learning environment. Each floor is supervised by a trained lady supervisor. Entry of unauthorized persons is strictly prohibited. Though every care is taken to ensure the safety and welfare of the students, if any accidents occur, the school is not responsible for the consequences.

4. AISSE 2022 results have been excellent with 100% pass, registering a quantum upward increase year on year. 37 students secured all A's in all subjects.

Yet another feather in our cap is GUINNESS WORLD RECORDS.

5. The medium of instruction and communication is English in the school. Fluency in English is considered as a vital requirement for all. The second language Hindi starts in class PP II. To fulfill the board requirements, a third language, Sanskrit is taught in classes VI to VIII. Telugu shall be taught as a compulsory subject from class I onwards as an additional language.
6. For holistic education, academic and non-academic activities are planned. Children are exposed to activities like yoga, music, dance, art & craft, outdoor sports & taekwondo. The school organizes special morning sports for classes III to XII in school from 7.30 am to 8.00 am for football, cricket & basket ball. Interested pupils must come by own transport in the morning.

Great care is taken in the way we recruit our teachers. Along with the requisite academic and professional qualifications, love for children, love for learning and passion for job are essential qualifications to be a SENTIA teacher.

7. At Sentia, curriculum is an ever evolving system encompassing various activities and experiences in school. Art, music, drama & sports are interwoven into the daily program to foster development of scientific aptitude, language and numerical skills. The curriculum champions self discovery, appreciates unique talent among children and builds a community of individual and collective excellence. It supports academic growth rigorous through project based and experiential learning.
8. The interactive boards which are an integral part of each and every class room from class I to XII, take learning beyond the text book and help children to wider their thought processes with great insight into topics dealt. The visual perception further heightens and reinforces the educational pursuits. Home assignment establishes a link between school and home. We view this as positive step for developing good work habits in later years. It is extension and review of what is done in the class.
9. Students of classes VI to XII are on the threshold of crucial learning. The teachers use innovative techniques to prepare them for broader horizons. The syllabi and the evaluation is as per the rules and norms prescribed by the C.B.S.E. We do not conduct any coaching classes for Olympiads and external exams. We believe in self study mode of preparation.

10. In accordance with the recommendations of the CBSE, the school will follow a uniform assessment scheme that stipulates a two semester system – complete with half yearly and annual examination. Two periodic tests will be conducted every semester.

Semester I (March 2023 to September 23)	Semester II (October 23 to March 24)
PT 1 – July 2023	PT 3- December 2023
PT 2 (Half Yearly)- September 2023	PT 4 (Annual Exams)- February/ March 2024

- PT: Periodic Test refers to evaluating a child’s performance in a holistic way, showing progress in various skills, attitudes and values. The progress of the students will be continuously reviewed through class test, subject enrichment activities, conversational skills etc.
 - Half Yearly & Annual exams: These help to evaluate and assess periodically the academic and intellectual growth of a child using various questions and techniques including MCQ’s, data interpretation, very short, short and long answer questions.
11. At the pre- school level, teachers lay a lot of emphasis on the play way method. Games are a natural means of teaching for little ones and are the integral part of every classroom. Teachers use flash cards to teach. Songs and rhymes are used to develop vocabulary. Teachers extensively use picture reading to help the students grasp new concepts. The curriculum is designed in a way which is both fun and challenging for the little ones. At this stage no exams are conducted but the performance is assessed on a day to day basis. The grading is continuous and comprehensive.
12. All Saturdays are holidays for classes PPI to III. Students of classes IV to XII shall have six days week with second Saturday as holiday.
13. A nominated body of students is appointed by the Principal in consultation with the coordinators and teachers. It functions under the Principal and sports department looking after the discipline and co-curricular activities in the school.
- The school does not provide meals to the students. We encourage our students to eat healthy home cooked food. The school provides a snacks shop for interested students.
 - Carrying of cell phones and other gadgets by the students in school premises is strictly prohibited. If found it will be confiscated and a fine of Rs.1000/- will be levied.
14. For emergency medical care, we are tied up with MIRRA HOSPITAL, JP Nagar, Miyapur which is about 2.5 kms from school. First aid facilities are available in the campus.

15. Regular field trips will be conducted as per the class & subject requirement.
16. Parent- Teacher meetings are regularly held in the school, at least 5 times in an academic year. Meeting subject teachers on regular working days is not permitted. Prior appointment should be taken from reception. If your child has special needs please discuss the same with the class teacher and school counsellor.
17. The academic year 2022-23 ends on 28th February 2023. Annual reports will be issued on 1st March 2023 for classes PP I to II, 3rd March 2023 for classes III to VI and 4th March 2023 for classes VII to IX & XI. Graduation ceremony for classes PPI & PPII will be held on 25th February 2023. The new sessions 2023-24 will begin on 9th March 2023 for classes IV to X & XII, 15th March 2023 for classes I to III and 20th March 2023 for classes PPI & PPII. The last working day for all classes is 22nd April 2023. The summer vacation will be from 24th April 2023 to 6th June 2023 for classes IV to XII and from 24th April 2023 to 10th June 2023 for classes PPI to III. All students have regular full day school from 8.10 am to 3.15 pm on all working days.
18. Books, school uniform, sportswear & taekwondo uniform counters are available in the school from 18/2/23 to 28/2/23 between 10 am to 2 pm. Students of classes I to X shall have Taekwondo.
19. Admissions for 2023-24 are in progress.
 - For new admissions the academic council of the school will pursue the registered applications and records the data and details furnished in the application form and code the specifications as per the details furnished.
 - It is not possible to meet teacher, coordinator or Principal while visiting the school for admission. However the admission team is available to answer any questions that you may have. If there are any queries that they are unable to answer, the correct information will be sent to you later or a meeting may be organized if required.
 - Admission of siblings is subject to availability of seats and performance of applications. Admission of a sibling cannot be claimed as a right and there is no sibling discount in fee.
 - The following selection procedures are maintained to finalize the new admission.
 - A) Availability of seats/vacancies
 - B) Order of registration.
 - C) Academic performance in the previous school as per the records produced for classes PPI to I.
 - D) Age restriction.

E) Performance of the candidates in the WRITTEN ENTRANCE TEST for classes I to XI in English, Mathematics and Hindi or PT 2/ PT4 report of the current year.

- As per the mandate of NEP 2020, entry age has been revised to 4 years plus for PP I & 6 years plus for class I as on 31st March 2023 from academic session 23-24.
- Applicant selected for admission should confirm the acceptance of the seat offered within 7 working days by remitting the tuition fee and submitting required documents.
- The following documents are required to complete the admission process.
 - A) Copy of progress report of the last class attended.
 - B) 2 passport size photographs of the student and one photo each of the parents.
 - C) Copy of birth certificate.
 - D) Copy of Aadhar card.
 - E) Transfer certificate from the previous school.
 - F) Health record sheet.

20. All fee payments are to be made by cash/crossed account payee local cheque/DD only.

- The cheque/DD to be drawn in favour of VIDYA KSHETRA EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY.
- Dishonoured cheque / DD will attract a penalty of Rs.300/-.
- The tuition fee has to be paid as per the schedule given. Thereafter late fee charges of Rs. 500/- for first ten days of delay and Rs.1200/- for next ten days of delay will be charged. The tuition fee doesn't include books, uniform & transport.
- Refund of any fee once paid to the school is not possible under any circumstances.
- The tuition fee payment timing is from 8.30 am to 2 pm on all working days.

21. School transport is optional and not mandatory. Parents need to select the most appropriate Bus & Route details, available on school website / admission department. Transport facility will be provided based on availability of vacant seat in the route opted for. In case vacant seat is not available parents should be prepared to send child by own transport. Change in the bus route during the year is not possible. The buses will ply in the existing routes and no new routes or stops will be added. A/C OR Non A/C transport may be provided on any route and bus route may be changed based on administrative convenience. Parents are requested to ensure that children are punctual and arrive at pick up points on time to avoid unnecessary delays. Children availing the school transport are not allowed to leave during the school hours as it would cause confusion to the transport staff. In case of unavoidable situations request from parents for their wards not to return home by school transport on any particular day must be received before 2 pm so as to avoid mix up or inconvenience.

- Management follows all the road safety regulations but will not be responsible for any mishap or accident on the way.
- The pickup and drop time along the bus route shall be communicated in the first week of March 2023.
- The bus fare ranges from Rs. 24,000 to Rs 32,000 per annum based on distance. 0 to 5 km – Rs .24,000/-; 5.1 to 10 km –Rs.29,000/-; 10.1 km and above Rs. 32,000/-
- The bus fare has to be paid in single installment on or before 28/02/2023.
- Students availing one way transport also need to pay the full two way fare for the complete year. Students will be picked up and dropped back at the same point for efficient functioning of the school transport. Pickup point and drop point cannot be different.
- Tuition fee and bus fee need to be paid for the complete year even if the child withdraws at any time during the academic year.
